Based on the Y Playing to Learn emergent curriculum our all day child care program is licensed by the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador. Parents can drop their children off any time after 7am and pick up any time before 6pm. The program includes breakfast, morning, afternoon and evening snacks, and a hot lunch.
