

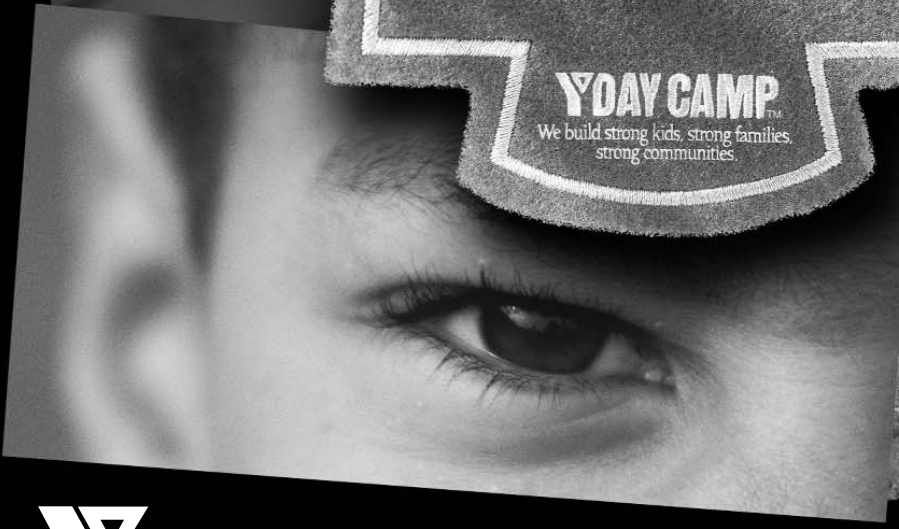

Our Programs

YMCA-YWCA day camps are designed to provide outdoor adventure and fun. Each camp has a theme and focuses on age appropriate activities to spark interest and imagination. Schedules are flexible enough to allow for individual differences and enable children to make choices and participate at their own pace.

Camp Adventure Ages 6 to 8

8:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. June 26 - Sept 1

Day camp based at St. John's Y and Mount Pearl Y. The emphasis is on outdoor play and physical activity; swimming, field trips, outdoor adventure; art activities and more. Children bring own nutritious lunches and snacks.

Cost: \$110.00/week per child

Camp Trailblazers Ages 9 to 12

8:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. June 26 - Sept 1

Bus stops at St. John's Y and Mount Pearl Y. Meet at the Y and travel daily to Foxtrap. New skills learned each week: canoeing, hiking, orienteering, swimming, sports as well as an optional overnight camp. Children bring sleeping bags and personal belongings for overnights.

Children bring own nutritious lunches and snacks.

Meals provided for sleep over.

Cost: \$130.00/week per child

Leadership Training Ages 13-17

July and August

For ages 13-17 Level I and Level II. Develop leadership skills in areas of camping and working with children. Skills can be transferred to any work setting.

Level 1: (3 weeks)

The perfect introduction to becoming a leader. Level 1 includes three weeks of practical on site experiences through assisting counselors in daily camp activities. Skills developed will include: qualities of strong leader, program planning, communication and working with youth at risk.

Cost: \$300.00 per child

Session 1 - June 25th - July 13th

Session 2 - July 16th - August 3rd

Session 3 - August 6th - August 24th

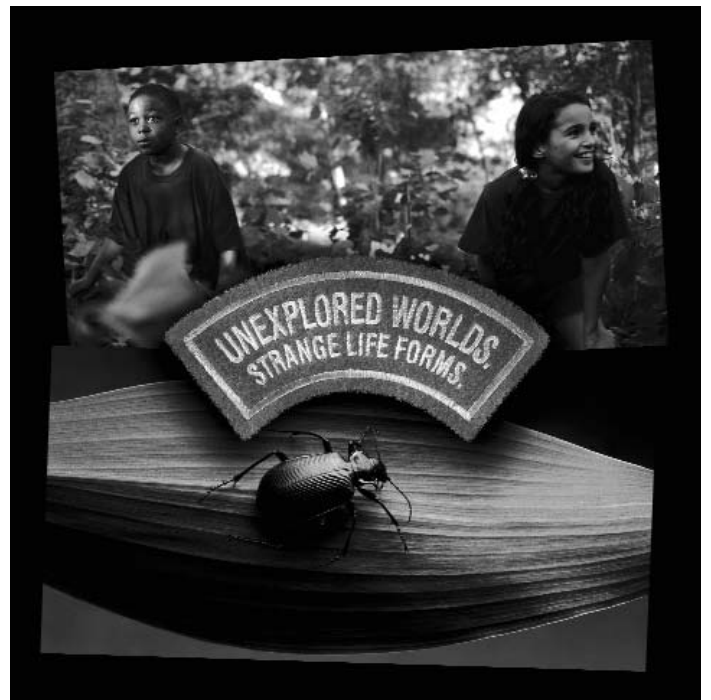
Level 2 (5 weeks)

Building upon the skills learned in Level 1, Level 2 applies that knowledge with a more hands on approach. Level 2 is an intensive five week program with a higher level of involvement. Each week the young leaders will be expected to design, lead and report on a planned activity. Training sessions will also be held to help the leaders develop their own skills. Canoeing, map and compass, camp fire safety and outdoors skills will all be covered.

Cost: \$500.00 per child

- All camps run Monday to Friday.
- If a refund is requested due to extenuating circumstances, a two-week notice is required, or a doctor's note in case of illness.

- Staff are on duty from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. for pre and post camp care. (Additional charge of \$10.00 week for 5:00 pm— 6:00 pm)
