## Our Programs

Y day camps are designed to provide outdoor adventure and fun. Each camp has a theme and focuses on age appropriate activities to spark interest and imagination. Schedules are flexible enough to allow for individual differences and enable children to make choices and participate at their own pace.

This summer, parents are invited to board the bus to Foxtrap for Family Fun Day. Here parents will get to see their children get back to basics and see what skills their children are learning. Family Fun Day will be held on July 20 and August 17.

## Day Camp Ages 6 to 8

8:00 am - 5:00 pm June 27 - September 2  
Day camp located at the Ches Penney Family Y and Mount Pearl Y. The emphasis is on outdoor play and physical activity; swimming, outdoor adventure; art activities and more. Children bring their own nutritious lunches and snacks.

**Cost:** \$150.00/week per child

## Outdoor Day Camp Ages 9 to 12

8:00 am - 5:00 pm June 27 - September 2  
Bus stops at the Ches Penney Family Y and Mount Pearl Y. Meet at the Y and travel daily to Foxtrap. Experience a true outdoor camping adventure at our rustic Foxtrap location. New skills learned each week: canoeing, hiking, orienteering, swimming, sports as well as an optional overnight camp. Children bring their own nutritious lunches and snacks.

**Cost:** \$155.00/week per child

## Leadership Development Camp

8:00 am - 4:00 pm  
Designed for ages 13-15, participants develop leadership skills in areas of camping and working with children. Skills can be transferred to any work setting.

## Level 1: (3 weeks)

Located at the Ches Penney Family Y and Mount Pearl Y, Level 1 is the perfect introduction to becoming a leader. Level 1 includes three weeks of practical on site experience assisting counsellors in daily camp activities in the Day Camp for ages 6-8. Skills development will include: qualities of a strong leader, program planning and interpersonal communication.

**Cost:** \$350.00 per child  
Session 1 - July 4 - July 22  
Session 2 - July 25 - August 12  
Session 3 - August 15 - September 2

## Level 2: (4 weeks & 5 weeks)

Located in Foxtrap. Building upon the skills learned in Level 1, Level 2 applies that knowledge with a more hands on approach. Level 2 is an intensive four and five week program with a higher level of involvement. Each week the youth leaders will be expected to design, lead and report on a planned activity at the Day Camp for ages 9-12.

Training sessions will help leaders develop their own skills. Canoeing, map and compass, campfire safety and outdoor skills will all be covered. The leaders will also receive certification in First Aid and CPR courses.

**Cost:** \$515.00 per child
